1 PRIMARY LIST

1.1 Team Leader

The Team Leader's duties include offering guidance and sound advice to other members of the team and acting as tactical situation commander in combat.

1.2 Loyalty Officer

The Loyalty Officer makes sure that treasonous thoughts are extinguished and looks for the early warning signs of CMT sympathy. Good Loyalty Officers spot and report potential CMTs weeks before they even commit treasonous acts.

1.3 Hygiene Officer

The Hygiene Officer performs the indispensable task of monitoring the personal hygiene levels of his fellow Troubleshooters. Without proper hygiene, Troubleshooter Teams are liable to suffer from misfires, poor morale and halitosis. Computer statistics show that a large portion of Troubleshooter missions fail due to poor hygiene.

1.4 Communications and Recording Officer

The Communications and Recording Officer gets to chronicle the mission using high-speed film, sensitive microphones and gripping colour commentary. This important assignment provides Our Mutual Friend with training material for other Troubleshooters. Good lighting and innovative camera angles are a must! The Communications and Recording Officer is also the

first point of contact for the team, and is responsible for official communications with The Computer and other bodies.

1.5 Equipment Officer

Central to an effective Troubleshooter Team is the Bots, Weapons, Vehicles and Sundry Equipment Repair and Maintenance Officer, more simply known as the Equipment Officer, or, less formally, as the Equipment Guy. The Equipment Officer controls the bots and vehicles assigned to the team and keeps a constant check on the equipment maintenance level of each Troubleshooter. Naturally, the Equipment Officer is also responsible for lost or stolen equipment.

1.6 Happiness Officer

Last but by no means least is the Happiness Officer, who makes sure that everyone has fun during the mission. He will do everything in his power to ensure a good time, including jokes, songs, citizen interaction games, and medication. Some say that "Biochemical Supplement" is a Happiness Officer's middle name. Teammates like him. A lot.

2 SECONDARY LIST

2.1 Bot Maintenance Officer

Computer research indicates that the constant termination of the Equipment Officers of large teams for failure to complete their Mandatory Bonus Duties is a waste of resources. The duties of a Bot Maintenance Officer are designed to lighten the load for the Equipment Officer, taking responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the team's assigned bots. In no way does this cause any tension between the two officers.

2.2 Advertising and Branding Officer

The Advertising and Branding Officer works to maintain the team's service firm endorsements, and keeps the team well supplied with merchandise displaying the logo of the team's sponsor. He ensures that sponsor logos are displayed at all times, and ensures that brand loyalty is maintained at all times. The use of competing brands is treason. He is also responsible for ensuring that the terms of endorsement are followed at all times.

2.3 Agent Provocateur

The Agent Provocateur works from the inside. He receives special training for infiltrating secret society meetings and for spotting the ringleaders in spontaneous criminal outbursts. He is to trick them into giving him important information by pretending to be loyal to their cause. Indeed, to the untrained eye, it should be as if the Agent Provocateur is truly in league with the traitors he is infiltrating.

2.4 Alertness Officer

The Alertness Officer ensures that the team is fully prepared for Commie ambushes and mutant attacks. He keeps the team on their toes, so that they are ready for anything. It is important that reaction times be kept to a minimum, and as such, Alertness Officers are authorised to administer Standard Alertness Tests, as well as Emergency Response Tests.

2.5 Financial Officer

It is the duty of the Financial Officer to manage his team's finances for maximum efficiency in the field. After all, money is power, and commerce is mandatory. If a teammate spends too much or too little during a mission, the Financial Officer will notice and step in to oversee things. In addition, the Financial Officer is authorised to administer Emergency Credit Checks to ensure the validity of all credits possessed by a teammate.

2.6 Medical Officer

The Medical Officer works tirelessly to ensure the safety and health of all his teammates. He is able to administer first aid if needed, and can offer advice to ensure that teammates are in top physical condition. He may require dietary or exercise routines to be upheld at all times.

2.7 Public Relations Officer
